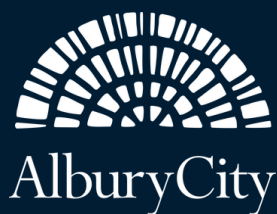

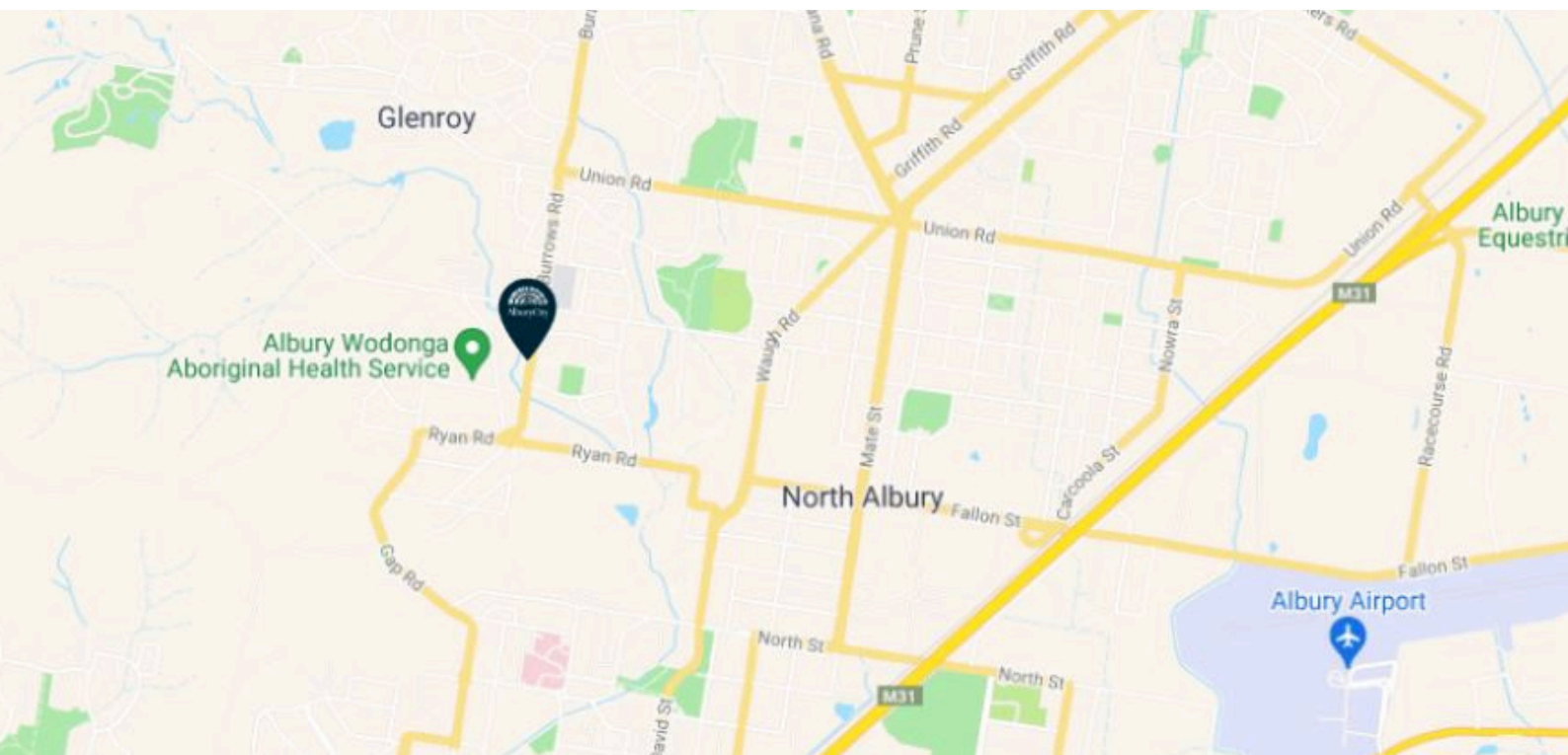


How to find us

Glenecho Community are to have a Dignity Vending Machines installed at our centre.

The machine dispenses free sanitary products to those experiencing hardship so they can easily access menstrual products.

The Dignity Vending Machine is a world-first innovation that dispenses a free period pack containing six tampons and two pads at the push of a button. Let's end Period Poverty.



Community Recycle Station

As an extension of the Albury Recycling Centre, residents can now drop off small hazardous and problem household waste types for recycling for FREE at any of the Community Recycling Stations.

Glenecho have a station at the centre and accept Fluro Globes, Mobile Phones and accessories, Smoke detectors and Household batteries

Graffiti Removal Kit
