Mirambeena, an Aboriginal word that means 'welcome', was officially opened in August 2003.

The Mirambeena Community Centre, Council's largest community centre, is located in the heart of Lavington.

Mirambeena was established with a focus on developing community spirit and fostering partnerships through the provision of services to people of all ages, abilities and backgrounds ranging from lessons in arts and crafts to supporting local charities, disability services and large annual & multicultural events.

Our Centre is available for hire by community and corporate groups. One of the Centre's greatest strengths is its versatility; we can accommodate groups from 2 to 300 people. Rooms are suitable for meetings, seminars and classes, and an on-site commercial kitchen is available. 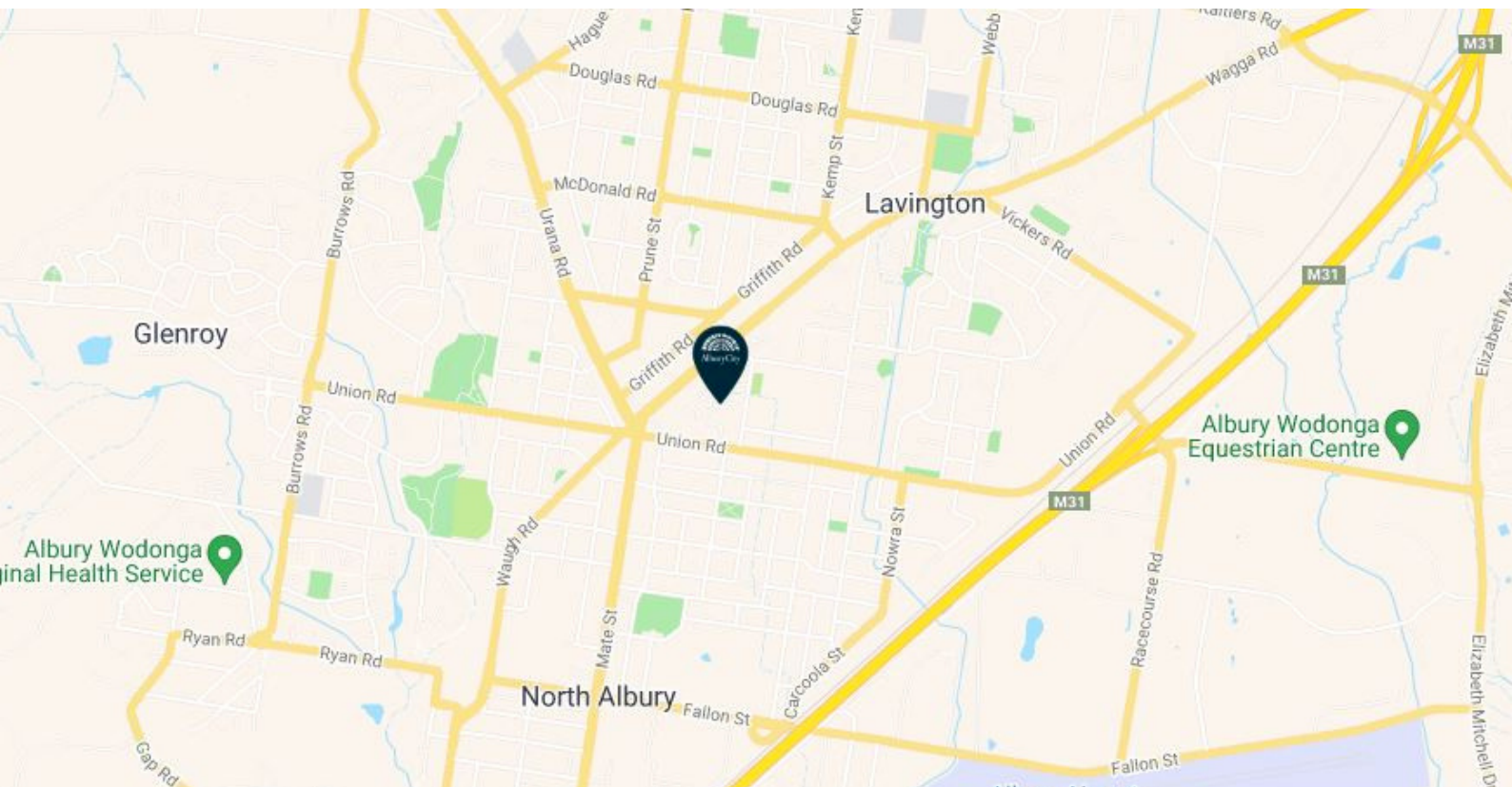


How to find us

Mirambeena Community Centre has a Dignity Vending Machine installed at our Centre in the women's toilets.

The machine dispenses free sanitary products to those experiencing hardship so they can easily access menstrual products.

The Dignity Vending Machine is a world-first innovation that dispenses a free period pack containing six tampons and two pads at the push of a button.

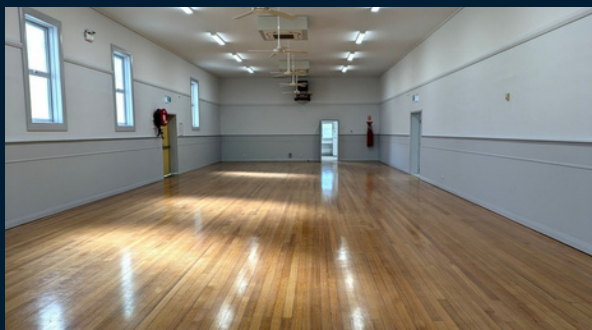
